Progress thus far from LMC01:

- Phase 2 of project as defined by edNET planned to be signed off before LM02.
- nPlusOne, which is the vehicle by which the telecomms services will be offered went live on 1st of June 2003.
- First marketing activity launch of nPlusOne at InternetWorld, Earls Court took place in June 2003.
- Associate participated in Operations activities to gain experience in potential problems beyond pure development work.
- Associate also participated in the Marketing activities to gain valuable feedback from potential users of the product in terms of utility value, human factors, pricings etc.
- Phase-2 work has been defined, evaluated and costings produced.
- Gantt chart to show this phase of work to be presented by M.D. Kurt-Elli at the LMC02 meeting.
- Objectives 4 and 5 are operational in parallel since development, integration and rollout is now based on a phased approach.
- Tasks 13 to 20 are repeated for each phase.
- Capital equipment expenditure on IP phones and gateways to be quantified and passed on to the financial controller of the project before next LMC.
